



Thank you for showing with Bluebonnet! We're looking forward to fun-filled show season. Below are guidelines for showing with Bluebonnet Arabian Horse Club in 2011.

- Check out is required. All accounts must be paid in full before leaving show grounds. Any participant not resolving their bill before leaving the show grounds will lose all points accrued and be subject to a \$25 fine.
- \$2 number deposit required, returned when number is returned.
 - option to keep number for complete show season, deposit returned at last show.
- Auditing of classes not permitted.
- No horse/rider combination may enter both walk/trot and walk/trot/canter classes.
- ASTM / SEI certified helmets are *required* for Hunter Hack and are strongly recommended for all participants in all classes.
- Money classes:
 - \$25 payback for Canter and Lope Championship Performance classes.
 - \$25 payback for Halter Grand Championship class.
 - Jackpot Trail Class Payout:

1-5 horses: 1st place 60%, 2nd place 40%

6-10 horses: 1st place 50%, 2nd place 30%, 3rd place 20%

11+ horses: 1st place 40%, 2nd place 30%, 3rd place 20%, 4th place 10%

Trail Classes: Trail Classes will run from 1pm -4pm in the outdoor warm-up area. If you are planning to ride in any Trail Classes, you **MUST SIGN IN** with the trail judge before 4pm.

Show Grounds: For the safety of all exhibitors and horses, lunging is not permitted within 25 feet of arena gate. Participants shall keep gate area clear for horses entering and exiting the gate.

High Point Program: Only current Bluebonnet Arabian Horse Club members are eligible to win high point awards. Points are not retroactive and exhibitors must compete in at least 2 open shows in the season to be eligible.
