The Mission Team weaves together Scripture, story-telling, faith-sharing, worship, and praise with emphasis on the healing power of Jesus in the Eucharist. There are prayers for physical, emotional, spiritual, and intergenerational healing. All of these things come together with a sufficient dose of humor mixed with good old-fashioned common sense!

A parish mission can be presented in consecutive evening or weekly sessions or in a weekend retreat format.

A time of upheaval, change, insecurity, fears about the future, abuses in the Church, natural disasters, famines, and terrifying sicknesses, no causes or remedies for new diseases, faithlessness as so many in the Church lose their faith and morals, corruption in society, moral decadence, bribery, infidelity particularly among clergy, wars, hostilities among nations, poverty, hunger, oppression, homelessness, greed, materialism, violence, political corruption, economic upheavals, crime in our midst, terror, financial disaster, and never-ending stories of suffering and loss striking fear in our hearts, robbing us of our inner peace, and paralyzing our spiritual journeys.

As terrifying as all of this sounds, it is not a portrayal of the world we live today. Rather, it is a descriptive account of 14th century Europe. There is perhaps one major difference between then and now. It is the constant sensory impact of the world on our souls—the visual and audible call to turn away from God and turn towards the things of this world. Nothing could be further from God's desire for us. He longs for us to accept Jesus Christ as our personal Lord and Savior and in so doing invoke the power of His Holy Spirit to come to our aid in leading lives of holiness—detaching ourselves more and more from the things of this world in preparation for our eternal home with Him in heaven.

The Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit—We work together for your eternal surprise!

It is not possible for us to grow holy without the Holy One guiding and directing our paths. Yet most of us are unaware of when and how God is calling us into a deeper relationship with Him. Most of us are completely oblivious to God's voice, to His promptings, and to His call on our lives. The reason is simple, we are not in relationship with Him. We don't know His voice. Furthermore we rarely communicate with Him and when we do it is a ONE WAY street. We talk, He listens. We never stop and listen for what He wants to say to us.

Simply put, we dial up God up when we need Him. However, unlike our telephone conversations with good friends, we have a one-sided conversation with God—we talk and He listens and when we are finished talking, we hang up. God is cut off and cut out of our lives without ever having a chance to respond to our call to Him and we cannot forget all the times He calls and we don't answer. Our ears are deaf to His call.

Is it possible to hear God speaking to you?

It is not only possible for each of us to hear God's voice, it is a fact that God will communicate directly to each one of us and guide our every movement in life if we ask Him to do so. It is a fact that we are able to hear God calling to us. It is not only possible, it is what God longs to do through the power His Holy Spirit at work in us. **Why not plan a parish mission to open hearts and minds, and ears and let God's voice be heard!**
